

BATTERY SORTING GUIDELINES

When batteries are collected as Household Hazardous Waste, they must be sorted by hand before they can be recycled. It is VERY HELPFUL if this is done before drop off.

Here's how: Simply put each kind of battery in its own labeled plastic bag

- 1) Alkaline
- 2) Button
- 3) Lead Acid (Pb) & Gel Cell
- 4) Lithium (Li)
- 5) Mercury
- 6) Nickel/Cadmium (Ni-Cd)
- 7) Zinc
- 8) Unknown

Batteries can be dropped off at the Regional Household Hazardous Waste Facility located at 1971 Brookdale Road in Naperville. It is behind Fire Station # 4 and is open every Saturday & Sunday from 9 am to 2 pm, excluding holidays. For more info - <http://www.naperville.il.us/hhw.aspx>.
